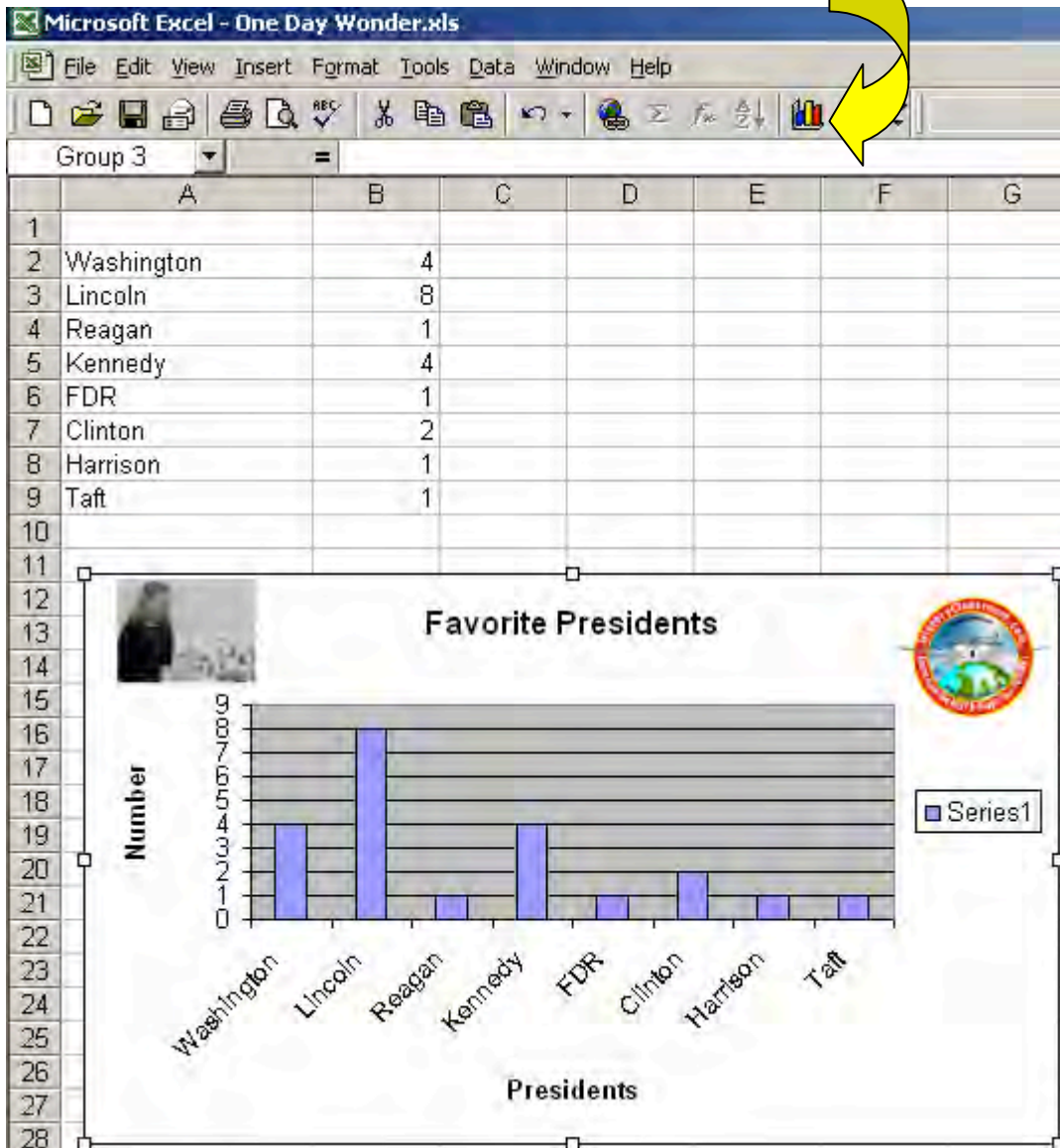

Directions:

1. Open Excel → Hold cursor over the right-hand side of FIRST Column, hold down the mouse button and drag it to the right to WIDEN the FIRST column (to the right).
2. SKIP the first Row.
3. Type your items (People's name, presidents, etc.) DOWN the FIRST Column
4. Type the NUMBER of votes for each item in the SECOND COLUMN (to the right of each item).
5. Highlight (click, hold, and drag the cursor over the boxes that you typed information into).
6. Click on the little Chart icon at the top of the screen.
7. Select Bar Graph Chart (Pie Graph if you are doing percentages) and click next.
Click Next again & Type Title (Ex. – Favorite Presidents)
8. The "X" axis will go ACROSS the BOTTOM of your chart. Type label (Ex. - "Presidents")
9. The "Y" axis will go UP the LEFT SIDE of your chart. Type label (Ex. - "Number of Votes")
10. Click "Finish". Google Images for a background and insert little pictures into your chart.
Select (click on) your chart and "Print Preview" BEFORE PRINTING.
11. INSERT --> TEXTBOX (with your Name and Block Number!)
