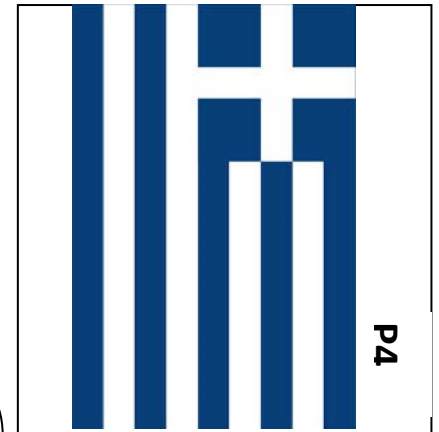

Let's talk about GOAL SETTING:

1. Achievable 2. Believable 3. Measureable (set mini-goals) Don't wait 'til the last minute to review

When you run into a "Brick Wall", Don't be Stubborn, Be Persistent!

STUBBORN - same method and same result.

PERSISTENT - different method to same goal but different result.

Try different methods to reach your goals!

Review your Spiral Ring Notebook - Vocab. & Graphic Organizers regularly.

If that doesn't work for you, Use tutorial before & after school and reviews with Mr. Peel.

If the textbook doesn't work for you, use the MP3 Audio with the textbook.

Was it the Multiple-Choice questions?

USE Mr. Peel's **4R MP3 TECHNIQUE**. (Record, Replay, Recite, Remember!)

- 1. RECORD** your notes onto an MP3 player. (Question, Pause, Answer.)
- 2. REPLAY** your notes morning and night each of the three days before the test (six times).

See if you can think of the answer before you hear yourself say it.

- 3. RECITE** (You might want to do this in a closet.)

Once during the six times that you listen to your notes, Read along **OUT LOUD** in your spiral-ring notebook (Notes) while you listen to yourself on your MP3 Player!

- 4. REMEMBER!** Leave the MP3 Player at Home! You've got it in your head!

It's almost like you have "mental fast forward & fast rewind buttons" in Your Head!

You can "Hear" yourself saying your notes!
