

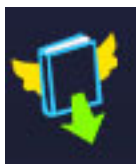
Library View



Thumbnail View: Default Library View shows a thumbnail image of the eBooks that have been downloaded to the Reader with the title beneath each image.



Cover Flow View: Shows a larger image of the eBooks that have been downloaded. Click on each title or move the slider bar to “flow” the titles.



Return Book: Removes an eBook from the Library View before the end the circulation period. Tell your librarian it was returned early to make sure the book is available to other users.



Delete Book: Removes an eBook from the Library View after the circulation period has expired.

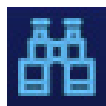


More Information: Opens the Title Information panel, providing details like the author and publisher, printing and copy & paste rights, and the circulation expiration time for the title.

Reader View



Show All Books: Switches to Library View, closing the current book.



Search: Search for specific words or phrases. Each click on the binoculars finds the next instance of the word or phrase.



Single-Page View: Displays the eBook one page at a time.



Dual-Page View: Displays the eBook two pages at a time; mimicking the view of a traditional print book.



GoTo Page: Navigates to a specific page in the eBook.



Jump to First Page: Jumps to the front cover or first page of the eBook.



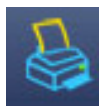
Previous Page: ‘Flips’ to the preceding page in the eBook.



Next Page: ‘Flips’ to the next page in the eBook.



Jump to Last Page: Jumps to the back cover or last page of the eBook.



Print: Opens the print dialog box, if printing is permitted by the publisher.



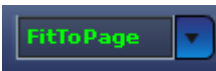
Add Note: Allows users to create notes, or highlighted notes to help find important information within the eBook.



Zoom In: Increases the size of the eBook text.



Zoom Out: Decreases the size of the eBook text.



Sizing Options: Allows users to select from a wide variety of display sizes from 10% up to 1600% of normal size. Options also include Fit to Width, Height, Visible or Page.

Book Info

Book Info: Shows details about the eBook that is open including Title, Author, Publisher, Print and Copy & Paste rights.

Bookmarks

Bookmarks: Publisher provided chapter headings or points of interest in the eBook can be seen if available. Bookmarks can be used as a shortcut to specific sections of an eBook.

Notes

Notes: Lists the Notes the user has made in the eBook.
